

Scarf

MEASUREMENTS

Scarf measures (approx) 15 x 150 cm

MATERIALS

Carnival Effects Stripes 8ply (100g balls)

Quantity 2

4.00mm crochet hook or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; wool needle for sewing in ends.

TENSION

This scarf has been designed at a tension of 16tr and 10 rows to 10cm over tr fabric, using 4.00mm hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **cm** = centimetres; **dc** = double crochet; **rep** = repeat; **tr** = treble.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Base (Foundation) chain = the length of chain made at the beginning of a piece of crochet as a basis for constructing the fabric.

Turning Chain = one or more chains, depending upon the length of stitch required, worked at the beginning of a row.

SCARF


Using 4.00mm hook, make 28ch.

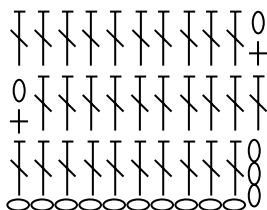
1st Row: Miss 3ch, 1tr in each ch to end ... 26tr (3ch counts as 1tr).

2nd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first tr, 1tr in each tr to end, 1tr in top of turning ch.

Rep 2nd row until scarf measures approx 150cm long. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Make a fringe 15cm long on each end.

o = chain (ch)

+ = double crochet (dc)

∩ = treble (tr)
