MEASUREMENTS

	S	M	L	
To Fit Size:	8-10	12-14	16-18	
Finished Measurement:	90	100	110	cm
Length:	54	55	56	cm
Sleeve Length:	43	43	43	cm

MATERIALS

Carnival Effects Fair Isle 8ply (100g balls)
Quantity 4 5 5 balls
One pair each of 3.25mm and 4.00mm knitting needles and a set of double-pointed 3.25mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 4 stitch holders; wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This garment has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00 mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg=begin/ning; **cm**=centimetres; **cont**=continue; **fol**=follows, following; **inc**=increase, increasing; **K**=knit; **P**=purl; **pss**=pass slipped st over; **rem**=remain/ing; **rep**=repeat; **st/s**=stitch/es; **stocking st**=1 row knit, 1 row purl; **sl**=slip; **tbl**=through back of loop; **tog**=together.

BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

Using a pair of 3.25mm needles, cast on 101 (111-123) sts.

1st Row (wrong side): Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles.

Work in stocking st (beg with a knit row) until work measures 33cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 95 (105-117) sts.

Sizes M and L only - 1st Row: K3, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3.

2nd Row: P3, P2tog, purl to last 5 sts, P2tog tbl, P3.

3rd Row: As 1st row.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows until (87-81) sts rem.

All Sizes - 1st Row: K3, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 33 (35-37) sts rem.

Leave rem 33 (35-37) sts on a stitch holder.

SLEEVES

Using a pair of 3.25mm needles, cast on 41 (43-43) sts.

1st Row (wrong side): Knit.

2nd Row: Purl.

3rd Row: Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles.

Work in stocking st (beg with a knit row), inc one st at each end of 3rd and foll 4th rows until there are 55 (69-81) sts, then in foll 6th rows until there are 85 (91-95) sts.

Cont (without further inc) until work measures 43cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

Shape Top:

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 79 (85-89) sts.

1st Row: K3, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3.

2nd Row: P3, P2tog, purl to last 5 sts, P2tog tbl, P3.

3rd Row: As 1st row.

4th Row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows until 67 (61-65) sts rem.

1st Row: K3, sl 1, K1, pss, knit to last 5 sts, K2tog, K3.

2nd Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 13 sts rem.

Leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

Join raglan seams, noting that tops of sleeves form part of neckline.

With right side facing, using a set of 3.25mm needles and beg at left back raglan seam, knit across all sts from stitch holders ... 92 (96-100) sts.

1st Round: K2tog, K9, (K2tog) twice, K29 (31-33), (K2tog) twice, K9, (K2tog) twice, K29 (31-33), K2tog ... 84 (88-92) sts.

Knit 9 rounds.

Purl 3 rounds.

Cast off purlways.

MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.
