## MATERIALS

**Carnival 8 ply** (100g balls)

Main Colour (MC)

2 2 2 3 4 4

Contrast Colour (CC)

1 2 2 3 3 4

One pair each 3.25mm and 4.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; knitter's needle for sewing seams.

## TENSION:

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing; **fol** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **st/s** = stitch/es; **stocking st** = 1 row knit, 1 row purl

## CHILD'S JUMPER - BACK AND FRONT

(ALIKE)

Using 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on **79 (85-91)** sts.

Work 5 rows stocking st.

**Hemline - Next Row** (wrong side): Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles and **beg Stripe Patt.**

**1st Row:** Using MC, knit.

**2nd Row:** Using MC, purl.

**3rd Row:** Using CC, knit.

**4th Row:** Using CC, purl.

These 4 rows form stripe patt.

Cont in stripe patt, until work measures **24 (27-30)** cm from **hemline**, ending with a purl row.

**Shape Armholes:**

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **75 (81-87)** sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **67 (73-77)** sts rem.

Cont in patt until work measures **38 (42-46)** cm from hemline, ending with a purl row.

**Shape Shoulders:**

Keeping stripes correct, cast off **6 (6-7)** sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **5 (7-7)** sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem **33 (35-35)** sts **loosely**.

## CHILD'S JUMPER - SLEEVES

Using 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on **37 (39-41)** sts.

Work 5 rows stocking st.

**Hemline - Next Row** (wrong side): Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles and work in stripe patt as given for Back, inc one st at each end of 5th and foll

**4th (6th-6th)** row/s until there are **41 (47-47)** sts, then in foll

**6th (8th-8th)** rows until there are **59 (63-67)** sts.

Cont in Stripe Patt (without further dec) until work measures approx **25 (31-35)** cm from beg, ending with the same stripe row as Back to beg of armholes.

**Shape Top:**

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **55 (59-63)** sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **47 (51-53)** sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Cast off **6 (7-7)** sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **6 (6-7)** sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 11 sts.

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## TO MAKE UP CHILD'S JUMPER

**NOTE:** We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder seams. Placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in sleeves evenly noting to match stripes at arm-hole shaping. Join side and sleeve seams. Turn up hems and slip stitch into place on wrong side. Fold front neck edge in 3cm and slip stitch loosely into position, tapering hem towards shoulder seams. Fold back neck edge in 2cm and slip stitch loosely into position, tapering hem towards shoulder seams.

## ADULT'S JUMPER - BACK AND FRONT (ALIKE)

Using 3.25 mm needles and MC, cast on **117** (129-139) sts.

Work 5 rows stocking st.

**Hemline - Next Row** (wrong side): Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles and **beg Stripe Patt.**

**1st Row:** Using MC, knit.

**2nd Row:** Using MC, purl.

**3rd Row:** Using CC, knit.

**4th Row:** Using CC, purl.

These 4 rows form stripe patt for rem.

Cont in patt, until work measures 47cm **for Woman** or 45cm **for Man** from **hemline**, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Armholes:

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **113** (125-135) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **97** (109-117) sts rem.

Cont in patt until work measures **68** (69-70) cm from **hemline**, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Shoulders:

Keeping stripes correct,

- **for Woman**, cast off **8** (10-11) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **8** (9-10) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem **49** (51-53) sts **loosely**.

- **for Man**, cast off **7** (9-9) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **8** (8-10) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem **53** (57-61) sts **loosely**.

## ADULT'S JUMPER - SLEEVES

**NOTE:** The Sleeves have been written in 6 sizes, Women's **S, M and L**, then Men's **S, M and L**.

Using 3.25mm needles and MC, cast on **49** (51-53-53-55-57) sts.

Work 5 rows stocking st.

**Hemline - Next Row** (wrong side): Knit.

Change to a pair of 4.00mm needles and work in stripe patt as given for Back, inc one st at each end of 5th and foll **6th** (4th-**4th-6th-6th-6th-4th**) row/s until there are **75** (55-**63-89-97-65**) sts, then in foll **8th** (6th-**6th-8th-8th-6th**) row/s until there are **85** (91-**95-95-99-103**) sts.

Cont in Stripe Patt (without further inc) until work measures approx **43** (43-**43-48-48-48**) cm from beg, ending with same stripe row as Back to beg of armhole shaping.

### Shape Top:

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **81** (87-**91-91-95-99**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **65** (71-**73-75-79-81**) sts rem.


Work 1 row.

Cast off **8** (9-**9-10-10-11**) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **8** (9-**10-9-11-10**) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 17 sts.
