## MEASUREMENTS :

	WOMAN			MAN

Finished Size:	98	103	108	113	118	123 cm
Length:	60	60	61	65	66	66 cm
Sleeve Length:	43	43	43	48	48	48 cm

## MATERIALS :

Quantity	Carnival 8ply (100g balls)					
	6	6	6	7	7	7

One pair each of 4.00mm and 3.25mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; a cable needle; 2 stitch holders; wool needle for sewing seams.

## TENSION :

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS :

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing;  **foll** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **incl** = inclusive, including; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **st/s** = stitch/es; **stocking st** = knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows.

**SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:** 'Cable' = Slip next 4 sts onto a cable needle and leave at back of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle.

## BACK :

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **99** (103-109-115-121-125) sts.

**1st Row:** K2, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**2nd Row:** K1, \* P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures 6cm, ending with a 1st row.

**Next Row:** Rib **16** (16-2-6-2-2), \* inc in next st, rib **1** (1-2-2-2-2), rep from \* to last **13** (13-2-4-2-0) sts, rib to end ...

**134** (140-144-150-160-166) sts.

Change to 4.00mm needles.

**1st Row:** K1 (4-6-9-2-5), \* P2, K8, P2, K12, rep from \* ending last rep with K1 (4-6-9-2-5), instead of K12.

**2nd Row:** Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times.

**9th Row:** K1 (4-6-9-2-5), \* P2, 'Cable', P2, K12, rep from \* ending last rep with K1 (4-6-9-2-5), instead of K12. Rep 2nd row once, then 1st and 2nd rows 7 times.

Last 24 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures **39** (39-39-42-42-42) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

**Shape Armholes:** Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **130** (136-140-146-156-162) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

**116** (122-126-128-138-144) sts rem. \*\*

Work **43** (43-47-47-49-49) rows patt without further dec.

**Shape Shoulders:** Cast off **9** (9-10-10-11-11) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then **8** (11-9-9-10-12) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem **46** (46-48-50-52-54) sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

## FRONT :

Work as given for Back to \*\*.

Work **27** (27-29-29-31-31) rows without further dec.

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### Shape Neck:

**Next Row:** Patt **48** (51-52-52-57-59), **turn**.

Cont on these **48** (51-52-52-57-59) sts for left side of neck. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **42** (45-48-48-51-53) sts rem, then in alt rows until **38** (41-42-42-46-48) sts rem. Work 1 row.

**Shape Shoulder:** Cast off **9** (9-10-10-11-11) sts at beg of next and alt rows 3 times in all, *AT SAME TIME* dec one st at neck edge in next and foll alt rows 3 times in all. Work 1 row. Cast off rem **8** (11-9-9-10-12) sts.

Slip next **20** (20-22-24-24-26) sts onto stitch holder and leave for neckband. With right side facing, join yarn to rem sts and patt to end. Keeping patt correct, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **42** (45-48-48-51-53) sts rem, then in alt rows until **37** (40-41-41-45-47) sts rem.

**Shape Shoulder:** Cast off **9** (9-10-10-11-11) sts at beg of next and alt rows 3 times in all, *AT SAME TIME* dec one st at neck edge in alt rows twice. Work 1 row. Cast off rem **8** (11-9-9-10-12) sts.

### SLEEVES :

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **49** (49-49-55-57-57) sts. Work 6cm rib as for Back, ending with a 1st row.

**Next Row:** Rib **4** (4-2-6-8-6), \* inc in next st, rib 1, rep from \* to last **3** (3-1-3-7-5) st/s, rib to end ...

**70** (70-72-78-78-80) sts.

Change to 4.00mm needles.

**1st Row:** **K5** (5-6-9-9-10), \* P2, K8, P2, K12, rep from \* ending last rep with **K5** (5-6-9-9-10) instead of K12.

**2nd Row:** Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows once.

Keeping patt correct as for Back as **placed** in last 4 rows and working extra sts into patt as they become available, inc one st at each end of next and foll

**4th** (4th-**4th**-4th-**4th**-alt) rows until there are **104** (110-112-122-122-86) sts, then in

**6th** (6th-**6th**-6th-**6th**-4th) rows until there are **112** (114-116-126-126-132) sts. Cont (without further inc) until work measures **43** (43-**43**-48-**48**-48) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

**Shape Top:** Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **108** (110-112-122-122-128) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until


**94** (96-**98**-104-**104**-110) sts rem. Work 1 row.

Cast off **10** (10-10-11-11-11) sts at beg of next 6 rows, then **8** (9-10-10-10-13) sts at beg of foll 2 rows. Cast off rem 18 sts.

### NECKBAND :

Join right shoulder seam. With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up **99** (99-**107**-111-**113**-117) sts evenly around neck incl sts from stitch holders, noting to dec 4 sts evenly across back stitch holder. Work 5cm rib as for Back. Cast off loosely in rib.

### TO MAKE UP :

Join left shoulder and neckband seam. Sew in sleeves. Fold neckband in half onto wrong side and slip-stitch loosely in position. 

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
