

Child's Fisherman's Rib Jumper

MEASUREMENTS	2	4	6	8	
To fit Chest:	55	60	65	70	
Finished Size:	63	68	74	82	cm
Length:	38	42	46	50	cm
Sleeve Length:	21	26	30	33	cm

MATERIALS : Carnival 8 ply (100g balls)
Quantity 3 3 4 5

One pair each of 3.25mm and 4.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 2 stitch holders; wool needle for sewing seams; **Size 2 years only** – 3.00mm crochet hook and 3 buttons for raglan opening.

TENSION : This handknit has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 44 rows to 10cm over Fisherman's Rib patt, using 4.00mm needles.



ABBREVIATIONS :

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **ch** = chain;
cm = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dc** = double crochet;
dec = decrease, decreasing; **fol** = follows, following;
inc = increase, increasing; **incl** = inclusive, including;
K = knit; **0** = (zero) – no sts, times or rows; **P** = purl;
patt = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **sl** = slip;
st/s = stitch/es; **tog** = together.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION :

'**K1B**' = knit below – insert needle through centre of st below next st on needle and knit this in the usual way, *AT SAME TIME* slipping st above off needle.

BACK :

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **71** (77-83-93) sts.

1st Row: K2, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

2nd Row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows until work measures **3** (3-4-4) cm from beg, ending with a 1st row.

Change to 4.00mm needles.

Beg Patt:

1st Row (wrong side): Knit.

2nd Row: P1, * '**K1B**', P1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form **Fisherman's Rib** patt.

Cont in patt until work measures **23** (25-27-28) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **65** (71-77-87) sts. **

Dec one st at each end of next and foll 4th rows until **37** (43-41-49) sts rem, then in alt rows until **27** (27-29-31) sts rem.

Work 1 row. Leave rem sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT :

Work as given for Back to **.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll 4th rows until **43** (47-47-53) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Shape Neck:

Next Row: Patt **15** (17-17-19) turn.

Cont on these **15** (17-17-19) sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec one st at armhole edge in next and foll 4th rows **3** (2-3-2) times in all, then in alt rows **5** (8-6-9) times, *AT SAME TIME* dec one st at neck edge in next and foll 4th rows **5** (5-6-6) times in all ... 2 sts.

Next Row: P2, turn, K2tog. Fasten off.

Slip next **13** (13-13-15) sts onto stitch holder and leave.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem **15** (17-17-19) sts and complete to correspond to other side of neck, reversing shaping.

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SLEEVES :

Using 3.25mm needles, cast on **35** (37-39-41) sts.

Work **3** (3-4-4) cm rib as given for lower band of Back, ending with a 1st row and inc 6 sts evenly across this row ... **41** (43-45-47) sts.

Change to 4.00mm needles.

Work in **Fisherman's Rib** patt as for Back and noting to work extra sts into patt, inc one st at each end of 6th and foll **8th** (10th-**10th**-12th) rows until there are

55 (53-53-59) sts, then in foll **10th** (12th-**12th**-14th) row/s until there are **57** (59-**63**-65) sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures **21** (26-**30**-33) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Raglan:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

51 (53-**57**-59) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll 4th rows until

29 (27-**23**-17) sts rem, then in alt rows until 7 sts rem.

Work 1 row. Cast off.

NECKBAND :


Join raglan seams, leaving left back raglan open for 9cm from neck edge and noting that tops of sleeves form part

of neckline. With right side facing and using 3.25mm needles, knit up **18** (18-**19**-21) sts evenly across top of left sleeve and down left side of front neck, **patt** across sts on front stitch holder, knit up **18** (18-**19**-21) sts evenly up right side of front neck and across top of right sleeve, then **patt** across sts on back stitch holder ... **76** (76-**80**-88) sts.

Next Row: K1 (0-0-0), * P1, K1, rep from * to last **1** (0-0-0) st/s, P1 (0-0-0).

Rep last row until neckband measures 5cm from beg. Cast off **loosely** in rib.

TO MAKE UP :

Size 2 years only – Fold neckband in half onto wrong side and slip-stitch loosely in position. With right side facing, using 3.00mm crochet hook and working through both thicknesses of neckband, work 2 rows dc evenly around raglan opening, working three 2ch button loops evenly along edge of Sleeve raglan in 2nd row. Sew buttons in position. **Sizes 4, 6 and 8 years only** – Join left back raglan seam. Fold neckband in half onto wrong side and slip-stitch loosely in position. **All Sizes** – Join side and sleeve seams. 

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
