

# Cropped Cardigan with set-in sleeves & Crochet Collar

## MEASUREMENTS

## MATERIALS

**Carnival 8ply** (100g balls)

Quantity	4	4	4	5
----------	---	---	---	---

One pair of 4.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 4.00mm crochet hook; a corset hook and eye; wool needle for sewing seams.

## TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm over stocking st, using 4.00mm needles.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dc** = double crochet; **dec** = decrease, decreasing;  **foll** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **K** = knit; **'M1'** = make 1 – pick up loop which lies before next st, place on left hand needle and knit into back of loop; **P** = purl; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **sl** = slip; **sl st** = slip stitch; **sp/s** = space/s; **st/s** = stitch/es; **stocking st** = knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows; **tog** = together; **tr** = treble.

**Turning Chain** = one, or more chains, depending upon the length of stitch required, worked at the beginning of a row.

## BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on **83** (95-105-117) sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end of next and foll 10th rows until there are **95** (107-117-129) sts.

Work a further 15 rows.

### Shape Armholes:

Cast off **6** (8-10-11) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **83** (91-97-107) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **71** (75-79-85) sts rem.

Work **39** (37-39-37) rows (without further dec).

### Shape Back Neck:

**Next Row:** K**19** (20-21-23), cast off next **33** (35-37-39) sts, knit to end.

Cont on these **19** (20-21-23) sts for left side of back neck, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **13** (14-15-17) sts rem.

### Shape Shoulder:

**Next Row:** Cast off **6** (6-7-8) sts, purl to last 2 sts, P2tog. Knit 1 row.

Cast off rem **6** (7-7-8) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem **19** (20-21-23) sts for right side of back neck.

Dec one st at neck edge in every row until **14** (15-16-18) sts rem.

### Shape Shoulder:

**Next Row:** Cast off **6** (6-7-8) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog.

**Next Row:** P2tog, purl to end.

Cast off rem **6** (7-7-8) sts.

## LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on **41** (47-52-58) sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at beg (side edge) of next and foll 10th rows until there are **47** (53-58-64) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Tie a marker at beg of last row to indicate beg of neck shaping.

### Shape Front Slope:

Dec one st at front edge in every row until **42** (48-55-61) sts rem, then in foll alt rows until **38** (44-50-56) sts rem.

Purl 1 row.

### Shape Armhole:

**Next Row:** Cast off 6 (8-10-11) sts, knit to last 2 sts, K2tog ... 31 (35-39-44) sts.

Dec one st at each end of foll alt rows until 19 (19-21-22) sts rem.  
Dec at front edge only in foll 6th rows until 12 (13-14-16) sts rem.  
Work 3 (7-3-7) rows.

### Shape Shoulder:

Cast off 6 (6-7-8) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 (7-7-8) sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 41 (47-52-58) sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at end (side edge) of next and foll 10th rows until there are 47 (53-58-64) sts.

Purl 1 row.

Tie a marker at end of last row to indicate beg of neck shaping.

### Shape Front Slope:

Dec one st at front edge in every row until 42 (48-55-61) sts rem, then in foll alt rows until 37 (43-49-55) sts rem.

### Shape Armhole:

**Next Row:** Cast off 6 (8-10-11) sts, purl to end ...

31 (35-39-44) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

19 (19-21-22) sts rem.

Dec at front edge only in foll 6th rows until 12 (13-14-16) sts rem.

Work 4 (8-4-8) rows.

### Shape Shoulder:

Work as given for Left Front shoulder shaping.

## SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 47 (51-51-53) sts.

Work 6 rows stocking st.

**Next Row:** K2, 'M1', knit to last 2 sts, 'M1', K2 ...

49 (53-53-55) sts.

Cont in stocking st, inc one st at each end (as in previous row) of foll 6th (6th-4th-4th) rows until there are 59 (79-71-91) sts, then in foll 8th (8th-6th-6th) rows until there are 77 (85-93-101) sts.

Cont (without further inc) until work measures 42cm from beg, ending with a purl row.

### Shape Top:

Cast off 3 (4-5-6) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 71 (77-83-89) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

51 (59-67-75) sts then in every row until 13 sts rem.

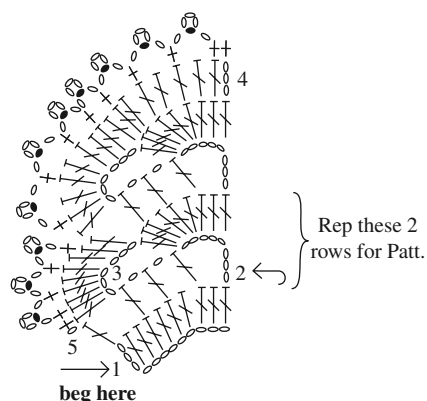
Cast off.

## COLLAR

**NOTE:** We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder and side seams.

Using 4.00mm hook, make 12ch.



### KEY

○ = chain (ch)

+ = double crochet (dc)

⌋ = treble (tr)

• = slip stitch (sl st)

**1st Row:** Miss 3ch, 1tr in each ch to end.

**2nd Row:** 8ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, \* 1ch, miss 1tr, 1tr in next tr, rep from \* once.

**3rd Row:** 6ch, miss 2 ch sps, 9tr into next ch sp.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until collar is long enough to fit around neck edge, from marker on left front to marker on right front.

**Next Row:** 3ch, 1tr in each of next 8tr, 8tr in ch sp, \* 9tr in next ch sp, rep from \* to turning ch of row 1, 1tr in turning ch.

**Next Row:** 1ch, 1dc in each of next 2tr, \* (4ch, sl st in 2nd ch, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1dc in next tr) 3 times, miss 2tr, 1dc in next tr, rep from \* to last 15 sts, (4ch, sl st in 2nd ch, 1ch, miss 1tr, 1dc in next tr) 7 times, 1dc in last st.

Work one row of dc evenly along side edge of collar.

With right side of cardigan and collar facing, beg at marker on right front and ending at marker on left front, join collar to neck edge of cardigan, working 1dc in every dc, then cont working dc evenly down left front edge to lower edge, work 3dc in corner, work dc along left front lower edge, back lower edge and right front lower edge, work 3dc in corner, then work dc along right front edge to base of collar. Work another round of dc around edge of collar and front and back edges. Fasten off.

## CUFFS

Placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in sleeves evenly. Join sleeve seams. Using 4.00mm hook, work an even number of dc around cuff.

Work another round dc.

**3rd Round:** 1ch, 1dc in first dc, \* 4ch, sl st in 2nd ch, 1ch, miss 1dc, 1dc in next dc, rep from \* to last dc, 4ch, sl st in 2nd ch, 1 ch, sl st into turning ch.

Fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Attach corset hook at base of collar. Fold collar onto right side.
