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MATERIALS

add one extra ball to quantities below for polo neck

Carnival 8 ply (100g balls)

Jumper

One **pair** of 4.00mm and a **set** each of 3.25mm and 4.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 2 stitch holders; knitter's needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

These handknits have been designed at a tension of 20 sts and 34 rows to 10cm over patt, using 4.00mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing; **foll** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **K** = knit; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **st/s** = stitch/es; **tog** = together;

CHILD'S JUMPER - BACK

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on **71 (75-83)** sts and **beg Patt**.

1st Row: K1, * P2, K2, rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

2nd Row: P1, * K2, P2, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures **24 (27-30)** cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

67 (71-79) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

57 (61-69) sts rem.

Cont in patt (without further shaping) until work measures **38 (42-46)** cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Shoulders:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **6 (6-8)** sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Leave rem **33 (37-37)** sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until there are **20 (20-22)** rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping.

Shape Neck:

Next Row: Patt **23 (24-28)**, **turn**.

** Keeping patt correct, cont on these **23 (24-28)** sts, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **19 (18-24)** sts rem, then in foll alt rows until **12 (12-16)** sts rem. **

Work 1 row patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **6 (6-8)** sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off rem **6 (6-8)** sts.

Slip next **11 (13-13)** sts onto a stitch holder and leave.

Join yarn to rem **23 (24-28)** sts and patt to end.

Rep from ** to **.

Work 2 rows patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Work as given for other shoulder shaping.

SLEEVES

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on 35 sts and work 4 rows patt as given for Back.

Keeping patt correct, **AT SAME TIME** working extra sts into patt as they become available, inc one st at each end of next and foll 8th rows until there are **53 (55-61)** sts, then in foll 10th row/s until there are **55 (59-63)** sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures

25 (31-35) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

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Shape Top:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

51 (55-59) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

41 (45-49) sts rem.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off **7 (8-9)** sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 13 sts in patt.

ROUND NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder seams. Using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **18 (19-19)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up **18 (19-19)** sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **80 (88-88)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * K1, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds 3 times (8 rounds patt in all).

Cast off **loosely** in patt.

POLO NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder seams. Using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **18 (19-19)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up **18 (19-19)** sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **80 (88-88)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * P2, K2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * K1, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds until neckband measures 17cm from beg. Cast off **loosely** in patt.

TO MAKE UP

Placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in sleeves evenly. Join side and sleeve seams. If making with polo neck, fold neckband onto right side.

CHILD'S HAT

Using a **set** of 3.25mm needles, cast on **96 (104)** sts and **beg Patt**.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * K1, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rounds form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 7cm from beg, ending with a 2nd round.

Change to a **set** of 4.00mm needles.

Work **28 (30)** rounds patt.

Shape Crown:

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2tog, K2, P2, rep from * to end ... **84 (91)** sts.

2ND ROUND: * K1, P1, K2, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

3RD ROUND: * K1, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

4TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K2, P2tog, K1, rep from * to end ... **72 (78)** sts.

5TH ROUND: * K1, P2, rep from * to end.

6TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K2, P1, K1, rep from * to end.

7TH ROUND: * K1, P2tog, K1, P2, rep from * to end ... **60 (65)** sts.

8TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, rep from * to end.

9TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K1, P2, rep from * to end.

10TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K1, P2tog, rep from * to end ... **48 (52)** sts.

11TH AND 12TH ROUNDS: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

13TH ROUND: * K1, K2tog, P1, rep from * to end ... **36 (39)** sts.

14TH AND 15TH ROUNDS: * K2, P1, rep from * to end.

16TH ROUND: * K1, K2tog, rep from * to end ... **24 (26)** sts.

17TH AND 18TH ROUNDS: Knit.

19TH ROUND: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... **12 (13)** sts.

Break yarn, thread through rem sts, draw up and fasten off securely. Fold band onto right side.

CHILD'S SCARF

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on 35 sts.

1st Row: * K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K2, P1.

Last row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 120cm from beg.

Cast off **loosely** in patt. Sew in ends.

ADULT'S JUMPER

NOTE: The Back and Front of this garment have been written in 3 sizes - **S, M and L**. The Sleeves have been written in 6 sizes - Woman's **S, M and L**, then Man's **S, M and L**.

BACK

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on **107 (119-127)** sts and **beg Patt**.

1st Row: K1, * P2, K2, rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

2nd Row: P1, * K2, P2, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 37cm from beg **for a Woman** or 45cm from beg **for a Man**, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

103 (115-123) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

83 (95-103) sts rem.

Cont in patt (without further dec) until work measures

58 (59-60)cm for a Woman or **68 (69-70) cm for a Man** from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Shoulders:

If making for a Woman proceed as follows:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **7 (8-10)** sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **7 (9-9)** sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem **41 (45-45)** sts on a stitch holder.

If making for a Man proceed as follows:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **6 (7-8)** sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **5 (7-9)** sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem **49 (53-53)** sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until there are **24 (26-28)** rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping.

If making for a Woman proceed as follows:

Shape Neck:

NEXT Row: Patt **34 (40-43)**, **turn**.

** Keeping patt correct, cont on these **34 (40-43)** sts, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **30 (34-41)** sts rem, then in foll alt rows until **21 (25-29)** sts rem. **

Work 1 row patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **7 (8-10)** sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off rem **7 (9-9)** sts.

Slip next **15 (15-17)** sts onto a stitch holder and leave.

Join yarn to rem **34 (40-43)** sts and patt to end.

Rep from ** to **.

Work 2 rows patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Work as given for other shoulder shaping.

If making for a Man proceed as follows:

Shape Neck:

NEXT Row: Patt **33 (39-43)**, **turn**.

** Keeping patt correct, cont on these **33 (39-43)** sts, dec one st at neck edge in every row until **23 (27-33)** sts rem, then in foll alt rows until **17 (21-25)** sts rem. **

Work 1 row patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Keeping patt correct, cast off **6 (7-8)** sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off rem **5 (7-9)** sts.

Slip next 17 sts onto a stitch holder and leave.

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Join yarn to rem **33 (39-43)** sts and patt to end.

Rep from **** to ****.

Work 2 rows patt.

Shape Shoulder:

Work as given for other shoulder shaping.

SLEEVES

The Sleeves have been written in 6 sizes, Women's **S, M and L**, then Men's **S, M and L**.

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on **43 (47-47-47-51-51)** sts.

Work 4 rows patt as given for Back.

Keeping patt correct, **AT SAME TIME** working extra sts into patt as they become available, inc one st at each end of next and foll 6th rows until there are **61 (65-81-65-69-85)** sts, then in foll 8th rows until there are **81 (85-89-89-93-97)** sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures

43 (43-43-48-48-48) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Top:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... **77 (81-85-85-89-93)** sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

57 (61-65-65-69-73) sts rem.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off **9 (10-11-11-12-13)** sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 21 sts in patt.

ROUND NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder seams.

If making for a Woman proceed as folls -

With right side facing, using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **24 (26-29)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up **24 (26-29)** sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **104 (112-120)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * P1, K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds 8 times (18 rounds patt in all)

Cast off **loosely** in patt.

If making for a Man proceed as folls -

With right side facing, using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **23 (25-25)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up **23 (25-25)** sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **112 (120-120)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * P1, K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds 11 times (24 rounds patt in all)

Cast off **loosely** in patt.

POLO NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join shoulder seams.

If making for a Woman proceed as folls -

With right side facing, using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **24 (26-29)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up

24 (26-29) sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **104 (112-120)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * P1, K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds until neckband measures 23cm from beg.

Cast off **loosely** in patt.

If making for a Man proceed as folls -

With right side facing, using a **set** of 4.00mm needles, beg at left shoulder seam, knit up **23 (25-25)** sts evenly along left front neck shaping, patt across sts from front neck stitch holder, knit up **23 (25-25)** sts evenly along right front neck shaping, then patt across sts from back neck stitch holder ... **112 (120-120)** sts.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * P1, K2, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep last 2 rounds until neckband measures 25cm from beg.

Cast off **loosely** in patt.

TO MAKE UP

Placing centre of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in sleeves evenly. Join side and sleeve seams. If making with polo neck, fold neckband onto right side.

ADULT'S HAT

Using a **set** of 3.25mm needles, cast on **112 (120)** sts and **beg Patt**.

1ST ROUND: * K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2ND ROUND: * K1, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rounds form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 9cm from beg.

Change to a **set** of 4.00mm needles.

Cont in patt until work measures **18 (19)** cm from beg, ending with a 2nd round.

Shape Crown:

1ST ROUND: * K1, P2tog, P1, K2, P2, rep from * to end ... **98 (105)** sts.

2ND AND 4TH ROUNDS: * K1, P1, K2, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

3RD ROUND: * K1, P2, K2, P2, rep from * to end.

5TH ROUND: * K1, P2, K1, P2tog, P1, rep from * to end ... **84 (90)** sts.

6TH AND 8TH ROUNDS: * K1, P1, K2, P1, K1, rep from * to end.

7TH ROUND: * K1, P2, rep from * to end.

9TH ROUND: * K1, P2tog, K1, P2, rep from * to end ... **70 (75)** sts.

10TH AND 12TH ROUNDS: * K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, rep from * to end.

11TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K1, P2, rep from * to end.

13TH ROUND: * K1, P1, K1, P2tog, rep from * to end ... **56 (60)** sts.

14TH, 15TH AND 16TH ROUNDS: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

17TH ROUND: * K1, K2tog, P1, rep from * to end ... **42 (45)** sts.

18TH, 19TH AND 20TH ROUNDS: * K2, P1, rep from * to end.

21ST ROUND: * K1, K2tog, rep from * to end ... **28 (30)** sts.

Knit 3 rounds.

25TH ROUND: * K2tog, rep from * to end ... **14 (15)** sts.

Break yarn, thread through rem sts, draw up and fasten off securely. Fold band onto right side.


ADULT'S SCARF

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on 47 sts.

1ST Row: * K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K2, P1.

Last row forms patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 150cm from beg.

Cast off **loosely** in patt. Sew in ends.
