

CARNIVAL

Kid's Zone 8ply

Uneven rib jumper with round neck and saddle shoulders

MEASUREMENTS

	2	4	6	8	years
To Fit Chest:	55	60	65	70	cm
Actual Measurement:	65	72	77	82	cm
Length:	36	40	44	48	cm
Sleeve Length:	23	28	33	38	cm

MATERIALS

Carnival Kids Zone 8ply (100g balls)

Quantity 3 3 4 4

One pair of 4.00mm and a set of double-pointed 4.00mm knitting needles or THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION; 1 stitch holder; wool needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 20 sts and 36 rows to 10cm over patt (slightly stretched), using 4.00mm needles.

BACK

Using a pair of 4.00mm needles, cast on 67 (75-79-83) sts.

Beg Patt:

1st Row: K1, * P2, K2, rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

2nd Row: P1, * K2, P2, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures 22 (25-28-30) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

63 (71-75-79) sts. **

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

55 (61-63-67) sts rem, then in foll 6th rows until **45** (51-53-55) sts rem.

Work 5 rows patt (without further dec).

Tie a marker at each end of last row.

Shape Shoulders:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next **10** (4-4-2) rows, then 3 sts at beg of foll **0** (6-6-8) rows.

Cast off rem **25** (25-27-27) sts.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to **.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

55 (61-63-67) sts rem, then in foll 6th rows until **47** (53-55-57) sts rem.

Work 3 rows patt.

Shape Neck:

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing; **foll** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **K** = knit; **0** = (zero) - no sts, rows or times; **P** = purl; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **st/s** = stitch/es; **tog** = together.

Next Row: Patt 18 (21-22-23), turn.

Cont on these **18** (21-22-23) sts for left side of neck.

Dec one st at armhole edge in foll alt row, *AT SAME TIME* dec one st at neck edge in every row **2** (2-4-4) times, then in foll alt row/s **2** (2-1-1) time/s ... **13** (16-16-17) sts.

Work 1 row patt.

Tie a marker at armhole edge of last row.

Shape Shoulder:

1st Row: Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts, patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog.

2nd Row: Patt to end.

3rd Row: Cast off **2** (2-2-3) sts, patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog.

4th Row: As 2nd row.

5th Row: Cast off **2** (3-3-3) sts, patt to last 2 sts, patt 2tog.

6th Row: As 2nd row.

7th Row: Cast off **2** (3-3-3) sts, patt to end.

Work 1 row patt.

Cast off rem **2** (3-3-3) sts.

Slip next 11 sts onto a stitch holder and leave for neckband.

With right side facing, join yarn to rem **18** (21-22-23) sts for right side of neck and patt to end.

Keeping patt correct, dec one st at armhole edge in foll alt row, *AT SAME TIME* dec one st at neck edge in every row **2** (2-4-4) times, then in foll alt rows **3** (3-2-2) times ...

12 (15-15-16) sts.

Tie a marker at armhole edge of last row.

Shape Shoulder:

1st Row: Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts, patt to end.

2nd Row: Patt 2tog, patt to end.

3rd Row: Cast off 2 (2-2-3) sts, patt to end.

4th Row: As 2nd row.

5th Row: Cast off 2 (3-3-3) sts, patt to end.

6th Row: Work 1 row patt.

Rep last 2 rows once.

Cast off rem 2 (3-3-3) sts in patt.

SLEEVES

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on 35 sts.

1st Row: K1, * P2, K2, rep from * to last 2 sts, P2.

2nd Row: P1, * K2, P2, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Last 2 rows form patt.

Keeping patt correct, and working extra sts into patt as they become available, inc one st at each end of next and foll 6th rows until there are **47** (49-47-63) sts, then in foll 8th rows until there are **55** (59-63-71) sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures **23** (28-33-38) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Top:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

51 (55-59-67) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until **43** (45-47-55) sts rem.

Work 1 row patt.

Keeping patt correct, cast off **5** (5-6-7) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then **6** (6-5-6) sts at beg of foll 2 rows ... **11** (13-13-15) sts.

Tie a marker at each end of last row.

Beg Saddle:

Cont in patt on these **11** (13-13-15) sts for saddle, dec one st at each end of 5th and foll 6th rows until **5** (7-7-9) sts rem.

Work **1** (7-7-9) row/s patt.

Cast off rem **5** (7-7-9) sts.

NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit (refer below).

Sew back and front shoulders to saddle at top of sleeve, matching markers and noting that sts cast off at top of saddle form part of neckline. With right side facing, using a **set** of 4.00mm needles and beg at back of left saddle, knit up **5** (5-7-7) sts evenly across top of left saddle, **13** (13-15-15) sts evenly along left front neck shaping, knit across 11 sts from front stitch holder, knit up **13** (13-15-15) sts evenly along right front neck shaping, **5** (5-7-7) sts evenly across top of right saddle, then knit up 25 sts evenly across back neck ... **72** (72-80-80) sts.

1st Round: K2 (2-0-2), * P2, K2, rep from * to last 2 (2-0-2) sts, P2 (2-0-2).


2nd Round: K0 (0-1-0), P1 (1-2-1), * K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 (3-1-3) st/s, K2 (2-1-2), P1 (1-0-1).

Rep last 2 rounds **3** (3-4-4) times, then 1st round once ...

9 (9-11-11) rounds rib in all.

Cast off loosely in rib.

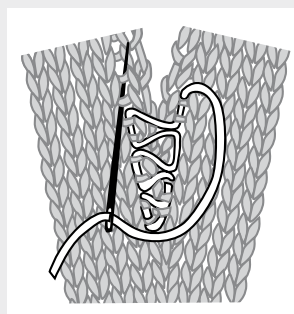
TO MAKE UP

Sew rem of sleeves into armholes. Join side and sleeve seams. 

Mattress Stitch

A 'Mattress Stitch' seam is almost invisible, so it is a good way to sew up your knitting. The seam is sewn from the right side so it is easy to see how to keep it straight and neat.

1. Put the two pieces next to each other, right side up and edges together.
2. Thread a wool needle with a long length of yarn.
3. Work one whole stitch (V shape) in from the edge and leave a long end before beginning to sew.
4. Put the needle between the edge stitch and the second stitch on the first row. Pass the needle under 2 rows (2 cross bars), then bring it back through to the front.
5. Repeat step 4 on the other piece.
6. Swap from side to side, always going into the hole that the last stitch on that side came out of.
Always go under 2 rows – be careful not to miss any rows.
7. Keep the seam firm but do not pull the yarn too tightly.
8. When the seam is finished, sew in ends.
