MEASUREMENTS - This garment is designed to be an easy fit							
Months (approx)		0	3	6	9	12	18
Fits underarm	cm	35	40	45	47	50	53
Garments measure (approx with correct tension)

Sleeve Length (approx)	cm	11	13	16	18	19	21
PATONS POWDERPUFF 50g balls							
Use only the yarn specified. Other yarns are likely to produce different results.							
Quantity (C1)		1	1	1	1	2	2
Quantity (C2)		1	1	1	1	2	2
Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters.							
Check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.							

NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair 5.00mm Knitting Needles or size needed to give correct tension.
- 2 Stitch Holders.
- A Wool Needle for sewing up.
- 2 (2-2-3-3-3) Buttons.

TENSION

14 sts and 26 rows to 10 cm over garter st, using 5.00mm Needles.

To work a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, use 5.00mm Needles, cast on 21 sts. Knit 39 rows garter st. Cast off loosely. Check your tension carefully. If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; **alt** = alternate; **beg** = begin or beginning; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreased, decreases or decreasing; **fol** = following or follows; **garter st** = every row knit; **inc** = increase, increased, increases or increasing; **patt** = pattern; **rem** = remain, remains, remainder or remaining; **st, sts** = stitch or stitches; **tog** = together; **0** = no rows, stitches or times; **cm** = centimetre(s); **approx** = approximate, approximately; **yfwd** = yarn forward – bring yarn under needle, then over into knitting position again, thus making a stitch.

BACK

With Correct Yarn and Tension, your garment will look like our photograph.

Using 5.00mm Needles and **C1**, cast on 32 (**34-38-40-42-46**) sts.

1st Row (wrong side) - Knit.

Note: Do not cut yarns after knitting required stripe rows, rather, carry them loosely along side of work on right side rows until required again.

Beg garter st stripes - Using **C2**, knit 2 rows garter st.

Using **C1**, knit 2 rows garter st.

Last 4 rows form garter st stripes.

Cont in garter st stripes until work measures 12 (**15-17-18-20-21**) cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

SHAPE ARMHOLES -

Keeping garter st stripes correct, cast off 2 (**2-2-2-2-3**) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 28 (**30-34-36-38-40**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, **sizes 12 and 18 months only** - then in foll alt row once.

All sizes ... 26 (**28-32-34-34-36**) sts. **

Work 23 (**25-29-31-29-31**) rows garter st stripes without shaping.

SHAPE SHOULDERS -

Cast off 4 (**4-5-5-5-5**) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 3 (**3-4-4-4-5**) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Leave rem 12 (**14-14-16-16-16**) sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Work 9 (**11-15-15-13-15**) rows garter st stripes without shaping.

SHAPE NECK -

Next row - K10 (**10-12-12-12-13**), **turn**.

Cont on these 10 (**10-12-12-12-13**) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 7 (**7-9-9-9-10**) sts rem.

Work 1 row.

Note: This side of neck is 6 (**6-6-8-8-8**) rows less to accommodate shoulder opening.

SHAPE SHOULDER -

Cast off 4 (**4-5-5-5-5**) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 3 (**3-4-4-4-5**) sts.

Slip next 6 (**8-8-10-10-10**) sts onto stitch holder and leave.

Join yarn to rem sts and knit to end.

Cont on last 10 (**10-12-12-12-13**) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 7 (**7-9-9-9-10**) rem.

Work 8 (**8-8-10-10-10**) rows garter st stripes without shaping.

SHAPE SHOULDER -

Cast off 4 (**4-5-5-5-5**) sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 3 (**3-4-4-4-5**) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 5.00mm Needles and **C1**, cast on 20 (**20-22-22-24-24**) sts.

Knit one row (wrong side).

Beg garter st stripes - Work in garter st stripes as for Back, inc one st at each end of foll 5th row, then in every foll 6th (**6th-8th-10th-10th-8th**) row until there are 24 (**26-26-26-28-28**) sts, then in every foll 8th (**8th-10th-12th-12th-10th**) row until there are 26 (**28-30-30-32-34**) sts.

Cont in garter st stripes without shaping until work measures approx 11 (**13-16-18-19-21**) cm (or length desired) from beg, ending with same garter st stripe row as for Back to beg of armhole shaping.

SHAPE TOP -

Keeping garter st stripes correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 22 (**24-26-26-28-30**) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll 4th row until 18 (**20-22-20-24-26**) sts rem, then in every foll alt row until 6 sts rem.

Work 1 row. Cast off.

NECKBAND

Using wool needle, join right shoulder seam.

With right side facing, using 5.00mm Needles and **C1**, knit up 5 sts evenly along left side of neck, knit across sts from front stitch holder, knit up 7 (**7-7-9-9-9**) sts evenly along right side of neck, then knit across sts from back stitch holder ... 30 (**34-34-40-40-40**) sts.

Knit 5 (**5-5-7-7-7**) rows garter st.

Cast off loosely knitways.

LEFT FRONT SHOULDER BAND

With right side facing, using 5.00mm Needles and **C1**, knit up 11 (**11-11-14-14-14**) sts evenly along left front shoulder and side edge of neckband.

Knit 2 (**2-2-3-3-3**) rows garter st.

Next row - K2, * yfwd, K2tog, K3 (**3-3-2-2-2**), rep from * 0 (**0-0-1-1-1**) time/s, yfwd, K2tog, K2 ... 2 (**2-2-3-3-3**) buttonholes.

Knit 2 (**2-2-3-3-3**) rows garter st.

Cast off loosely knitways.

LEFT BACK SHOULDER BAND

With right side facing, using 5.00mm Needles and **C1**, knit up 11 (**11-11-14-14-14**) sts evenly side edge of neckband and left back shoulder.

Knit 5 (**5-5-7-7-7**) rows garter st.

Cast off loosely knitways.

MAKE UP

DO NOT PRESS. Using wool needle sew in all ends. Place left front shoulder band over left back shoulder band and oversew together at shoulder sleeve edge. Using wool needle, join side and sleeve seams, matching stripes. Sew in sleeves, working through both thicknesses of shoulder bands. Sew on buttons.
