MATERIALS

Carnival 8 ply (100g balls)

Quantity	4	5	5	6
----------	---	---	---	---

One **pair** of 4.00mm and a **circular** 4.00mm knitting needle or **THE REQUIRED SIZE TO GIVE CORRECT TENSION**;
4 stitch holders; knitter's needle for sewing seams.

TENSION

This handknit has been designed at a tension of 21 sts and 34 rows to 10cm over body patt (slightly stretched), using 4.00mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin/ning; **cm** = centimetres; **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease, decreasing; **fol** = follows, following; **inc** = increase, increasing; **incl** = inclusive, including; **K** = knit; **0** = (zero) – no sts, rows or times
P = purl; **patt** = pattern; **psso** = pass slipped st over; **rem** = remain/ing; **rep** = repeat; **sl** = slip; **st/s** = stitch/es; **tbl** = through back of loop; **tog** = together;

BACK AND FRONT ALIKE

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on **95** (104-119-128) sts.

1st Row: K2, * P1, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: P2, * K1, P2, rep from * to end.

3rd Row: Purl.

4th Row: As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 4 incl form patt for Back and Front.

Cont in patt until work measures 32cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Raglan Armholes:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

91 (100-115-124) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll alt rows until

49 (56-67-72) sts rem.

Work 1 row patt.

Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

SLEEVES

Using a **pair** of 4.00mm needles, cast on **47** (47-47-50) sts.

1st Row: K2, * P1, K2, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: P2, * K1, P2, rep from * to end.

Last 2 rows form patt for Sleeves.

Work a further 6 rows patt.

Keeping patt correct and working extra sts into patt as they become available, **AT SAME TIME** inc one st at each end of next and foll **8th** (6th-4th-4th) rows until there are **61** (69-55-76) sts, then in foll **10th** (8th-6th-6th) row/s until there are **73** (81-87-96) sts.

Cont in patt (without further inc) until work measures 43cm from beg, working last row on wrong side.

Shape Raglan:

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows ...

69 (77-83-92) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next and foll 4th rows until

47 (53-57-64) sts rem.

Work **3** (1-1-1) row/s patt.

Tie a marker at each end of last row (to indicate end of seam).

Beg Turnings:

NOTE: When turning, take yarn under needle and onto other side of work, slip next st onto right hand needle, take yarn under needle and back to original position, slip st back onto left hand needle, then turn and proceed as instructed. This avoids holes in work.

Square Neck, Textured Rib Jumper

1st and 2nd Rows: Patt to last 2 sts, **turn**.

3rd and 4th Rows: Patt to last 4 sts, **turn**.

5th and 6th Rows: Patt to last 6 sts, **turn**.

7th and 8th Rows: Patt to last 8 sts, **turn**.

Cont in this manner until row '*Patt to last 14 sts, turn*' has been worked twice.

Next Row: Patt 2tog, patt **15** (21-25-32), patt 2tog, patt 14 ...

45 (51-55-62) sts.

Leave sts on a stitch holder for neckband.

NECKBAND

NOTE: We recommend using 'Mattress St' to sew up your handknit.

Join raglan seams, noting that sleeve markers indicate where to end sewing raglan seams. With right side facing, using a 4.00mm **circular** needle and beg with sts from left sleeve stitch holder: Sl 1 (to be worked into K2tog at end of round), knit across left sleeve stitch holder to last st *AT SAME TIME* dec **6** (6-6-5) sts evenly across, knit last st tog with first st on front stitch holder (corner st), knit to last st on front stitch holder *AT SAME TIME* dec **0** (1-0-1) st/s evenly across, knit last st tog with first st on right sleeve stitch holder (corner st), knit across right sleeve stitch holder to last st *AT SAME TIME* dec **6** (6-6-5) sts evenly across, knit last st tog with first st on back stitch holder (corner st), knit to last st on back stitch holder *AT SAME TIME* dec **0** (1-0-1) st/s evenly across, knit last st tog with slipped st from left sleeve (corner st) ... **172** (196-228-252) sts.

1st Round: * P2tog, (K1, P1) to within 3 sts of corner st, K1, P2tog tbl, K1 (corner st), rep from * 3 times ...

164 (188-220-244) sts.

2nd Round: * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

3rd Round: * K2tog, P1, (K1, P1) to within 2 sts of corner st, sl 1, K1, pss0, K1 (corner st), rep from * 3 times ...

156 (182-212-236) sts.

4th Round: K1, * (K1, P1) to within one st of corner st, K2, rep from * 3 times.

Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams.
